

# Do I need to wear a Mask?

Information on when or if you need to wear a mask:

- **You MUST cover your face from Friday July 24th.**
- **You can use a scarf or specially designed mask**
- **Anyone shopping without a mask, unless medically exempt, could face a £100 fine.**

## Who Needs to Wear a Mask?

- People working in salons
- People working in or visiting Doctors surgeries & hospitals
- Everyone in a shop or supermarket unless under 11 or has a medical reason
- Everyone on public transport unless under 11 or has a medical reason



## If You Are Deaf or Need to Lip Read?

Step back 2 metres, lower your mask or use a notepad

## Who Doesn't Need to Wear a Mask?

People who work in shops don't have to wear masks or face coverings.

### You don't need to if:

- You have a disability that means you cannot put a mask on.
- You have a disability that means you cannot wear or remove a mask.
- Putting on a face mask would cause you severe distress or anxiety.
- If you lip read the person supporting you to use public transport does not have to wear a mask.
- You do not have to wear a mask if you are using public transport to escape danger.



## When can you remove your mask?

- Eat
- Drink
- Take medication

## Who Will Enforce the Rules?

- You can be refused entry for not wearing a mask.
- The police will ensure people wear them who need to.

## Public Transport.

Since June 15th.  
Anyone travelling by the following:

- Bus
- Ferry
- Plane
- Train
- Uber

In England you must wear a face covering.

You don't need to (unless told to) if:

- You are under 11
- You have a disability
- You have breathing difficulties
- You are travelling with someone who relies on lip reading
- If you must eat or drink
- School transport
- Taxis
- Private hire vehicles unless told to



## Remember:



- Help keep yourself, family, friends, employees and other customers safe by wearing a face covering or mask
  - **Socially distance by at least 1 metre**
- Follow the rules unless told otherwise
  - **Follow the arrows on the floor**
- Wash and sanitise your hands often
